


Using your Neighborhood Watch

Your Neighborhood Watch Internet site has been set up with its own unique URL. This will typically be a combination of GetMyNWsite.com and your neighborhood name, city and state.

For example, www.GetMyNWsite.com/CloverRidge.Powell.OH

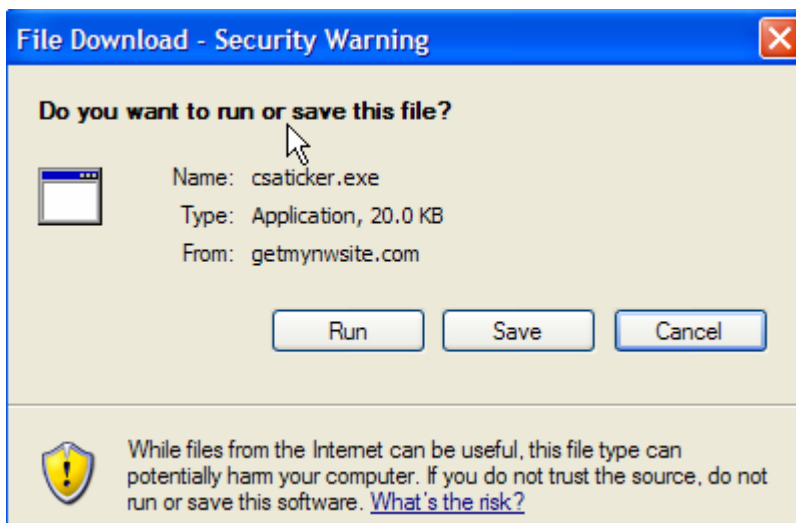

Get Ticker:

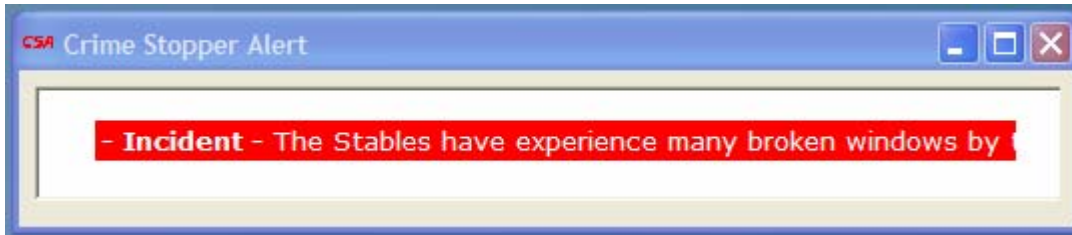
Members have the ability to use the Get Ticker option to download a customized Crime Stopper Alert ticker which monitors your neighborhood alert.





This ticker can be saved to desktops and automatically loaded through your Windows Start Programs.

Your Alert will be dispatch to those tickers loading and monitoring your Neighborhood Watch.



Note: Tickers can only be changed or removed by your site administrator. When Alert can be activated you should contact your site Administrator to have the Alert removed.
